

Election of HSBA Position on JUDICIAL SELECTION COMMISSION

The term of Judicial Selection Commissioner Rosemary Fazio, who was appointed by the Bar, will expire April 1, 2009. **Article VI, Section 4** of the **Hawai'i Constitution** says:

"[m]embers in good standing of the bar of the State shall elect two of their number to the commission in an election conducted by the Supreme Court or its delegate."

The Supreme Court of Hawai'i has delegated the task of conducting the Bar's election to fill the vacancy to the Hawai'i State Bar Association (HSBA) and the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i. The election will be conducted along with the HSBA's election of officers.
