This CD-ROM is revised annually and is available for a nominal charge. Order forms may be obtained at the Department's website, at any district tax office or by calling our Forms and Publications By Mail Request Line.

The Tax Information CD contains tax forms with writable fields for the current year, unofficial

compilations of the Hawaii Tax Statutes and Administrative Tax Rules, selected unpublished court decisions, and attorney general tax opinions, informational brochures, publications, releases, reports, and more.

Hawaii Business Express One-Stop Business Registration:

www.hbe.hawaii.gov

Obtain your general excise and other business tax registrations on-line and register with the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations at the same time.

Just answer a series of questions and authorize the payment of any fees by credit card. Your business registration forms are automatically filled in and electronically transmitted to the appropriate department.

Electronic Filing Via the Internet (ELF):

www.ehawaii.gov/efile

You can submit a number of tax forms and payments via the Internet through ELF, including Form N-13, selected general excise, withholding, and transient accommodations tax returns, estimated taxes, filing extension requests, and applications for tax clearances.

Credit card payments are accepted; however, a processing fee charged by the credit card companies will be added to the transaction.

Bulk Filing Via the Internet:

Tax professionals and others who file periodic and/or annual transient accommodations tax returns or periodic withholding tax returns for their clients may submit these returns as a single electronic file via the Internet.

From the Department's website (www.hawaii.gov/tax), select the Bulk Filing link under "Spotlight".

Joint Federal/State Electronic Filing (JELF):

Electronically file your individual income tax return via the Internet at the same time you file your federal income tax return. Use approved tax preparation software or ask your tax professional.

If you contact the Department numerous times and still can't resolve a tax problem, the Taxpayer Advocate may be able to help. The following information is required:

- Taxpayer information (name, ID numbers, etc.)
- Daytime telephone number and best time to call
- Nature of the problem (type of tax, tax form, period and year, etc.)
- Details of previous attempts to resolve the problem (dates, office, and person contacted, etc.)
